Over the years I have been able to see many broken people like them who don't have much in this world, but will have much in the world to come. They are always inviting other homeless people to the church so they can hear the gospel. Please pray for these new converts that God would meet their spiritual needs.

In August we had a baptism. Nine Souls were baptized. Nina, one of our ladies, got saved about year ago after coming to the church for four years. She couldn't wait to get baptized and make public what already took place in her soul. Nina had to retire early because of a serious accident in a factory where she worked. Apparently, one of the steel beams in a ceiling fell on her while working sewing clothes. It left her unable to walk for several years and required multiple surgeries. Her surgery during the Soviet Union was a real "butcher job," leaving her leg unusually bent. She lives in pain much of the time.
