Vianey, a faithful lady in the church lost her husband unexpectedly to a brain aneurysm, leaving behind three teenage boys. The opportunity to participate at funerals has opened up doors and allowed us to testify to many lost family members and friends.

On a happier note, in November we will be celebrating the 19th anniversary of the Mount Calvary Baptist Church in Tula. We are grateful to God for all that He has done in the past and look forward to all that He has in store for us. You have been a part of this through your faithful prayers and support.
