“FOR BIBLES”**

“Our Open Bible classes now reach four different Mindanao tribes. In Yahoola #2, Ilib: Tiruray, Manobo, as well as T'boli tribes. Pastor Edwin Dading holds classes to B'laan and T'boli tribes in Paraiso. Understanding of English is little; most have not finished even primary school. All are 90% conversant in Ilongo. **Eagerness to learn the Bible can be helped if we can provide the churches with Ilongo Bibles.** *There are four different kinds of Ilongo Bibles: SIL, Good News, and a very poor and inaccurate Ilongo translation done by a missionary out of Pensacola.* The old Ilongo Translation of 1925 by American Missionaries is recommended as it is closer to the KJB. The Ilongo is more "archaic" but not so vulgar and modernized like the other translations. We can purchase the Ilongo Bibles in PI city bookstores at 600 pesos each.”—Roger Bayona

We will purchase good quality print hardback Bibles to endure the humidity. EOTEM has sent today \$2500 out of our “new church fund” to purchase 200 Ilongo Bibles. Current exchange rate is \$1=49.48 pesos. If you can help us meet this need, please mark your offering “for Bibles”.
