We thank God that everything is stable with the Philippine ministry—both Panay and Mindanao Bible schools going, remote area churches started, buildings built and, most importantly, souls saved.

The mainland training center in Harbin, China (operates as a kindergarten front) is facing some economic problems due to school class suspension until Coronavirus situation is clear. All school attendance is suspended until further notice. No attendance means no tuition from students—therefore, no rent or payment to K-4 teachers can be made.

Our daughter, Catherine, teaches at a Hong Kong Christian private school (over 1,000 students in the school). All school attendance is also suspended there since January 15 until April 20. Her husband, Jonathan, is Pastor of Island Baptist Church. Church services have also been reduced. Their three children (Steven 12, Lucy 10, and Nicholas 6) must also be home schooled during this time. I did get to preach in Island Baptist Church (February 2) to 30 Filipino workers in HK. (over 170,000 Filipinos work as domestic help in HK)

We intended to leave from Hong Kong to the Philippines during February, but were not allowed to fly from HK due to Philippines President Duterte's prohibition of all flights from Mainland and Hong Kong, China due to Coronavirus epidemic.

After our return to the USA from HK, Sue experienced nausea, extreme weakness, chest pains and is now in WA hospital for tests. Her prognosis is uncertain now, but all virus infection has been ruled out. Please pray for her.

"Making request, if by any means now at length I might have a prosperous journey by the will of God to come unto you." (Romans 1:10)

Paul intended a "prosperous" trip to Rome "by the will of God". He got there—but in shackles, a snakebite, storm and shipwreck along the way. Our thoughts and ways, as well as our definition of "prosperous", are not always the same as God's.

In the midst of all trials and troubles, we stand steady and sing a favorite hymn:

'When darkness seems to hide His lovely face, I rest on His unchanging grace.

In every high and stormy gale, My anchor holds within the veil.
